"With CUMO, it is our goal to have the lowest cost, large-scale producing molybdenum mine in within a five and six year time frame. We expect to initially mine at a rate of about 125,000 tons of ore per day containing molybdenum, copper, silver, rhenium and tungsten. We are aiming to produce molybdenum at about \$3/1b, and if we anticipate \$15/1b molybdenum (prices), that is clearly economic. We will be the lowest cost producer, primary producer, mainly because of the size of the deposit and consequent economy of scale. "
